

General information



1. Entries are free of charge

2. Conduct of the tournament:

- SuperLiga and DIV II: 4+1 system, BJLEK small field rules
- DIV III and Women's League: 5+1 system, BJLEK rules for small pitches
- SuperLeague with participation of the pre-qualified DIV I teams and the DIV II teams that join them
- **the maximum number of teams is 12 and cannot be changed during the tournament, except during the draft period and/or in cases of force majeure as determined by the organisers, which does not apply to the knock-out phase**
- **draft period only and exclusively after the group matches, up to 8 teams 2 players, 9-12 teams 1 player can be drafted and written permission must be requested from the Competition Committee**
- playing time of matches: SuperLiga, DIV II, DIV III - 2x25 minutes, Women's League 2x20 minutes
- SuperLeague and DIV II divisions may be combined if there are not enough teams in either division. (Minimum 16 teams, indicative)
- unlimited number of teams can participate in DIV III and Women's League
- for Superleague-DIV II, a President's Cup will be held once a year, in the spring semester
- teams that have qualified in the top four (DIV II and DIV III) are automatically promoted to the higher division are entered into the higher divisions

3. Participation or participation is open to:

- students of the University of Debrecen and its associated institutions (full-time, evening, correspondence, distance learning)
- students of the University of Debrecen FOSZ courses
- former students of the University of Debrecen and its associated institutions (in accordance with the University's Alumni Rules and Regulations in accordance with the)
- lecturer, employee of the University of Debrecen and its associated institutions
- member of a sports organisation of the University of Debrecen, certified competitor, if he/she has DE student, employee or alumni status
- member of a sports organisation of the University of Debrecen, certified competitor, if not DE student, employee or alumni status, the Competition Committee shall decide on the eligibility of these players, and only the Committee may issue a valid competition licence. The number of such players shall be 1 per team up to a maximum of 8 players per team, and 2 per team for teams of 9-12 players.
- professional football players with a certificate from their association, if they are students, employees or alumni of the University of Debrecen

4. Overlaps

- a player may only play in one division
- a player who is ineligible may be banned, have points deducted from his team or even be expelled

5. Posting of match results and postponement of matches:

- results must be uploaded to <http://www.buzanszkykupa.hu> within two days (48 hours), failure to do so may result in deduction of points or, in the event of a repetition, disqualification
- **a team may postpone a maximum of 2 times (if it qualifies from the group stage), 1 time in the regular season and 1 time in the knockout stage**
- if, contrary to the timetable, teams agree to set up a match in their group and play it at the venue they have agreed, they will receive a 0.5 postponement credit
- **each team is obliged to tick at least two days of the "Matchable dates" indicated on the website, with a minimum of 6 occasions**

6. Players' clearance:

- before matches, the opponents shall, in their own interest, mutually check each other's players until the referees start their operations and communicate the fact and the result of the check to the referee involved in the match
- a record of the players who take the field of play in matches and of the events of the match must be kept and deposited in the collection box in the Koli Café (located in the KLIK III Dormitory building)
- random checks by members of the Competition Committee and by the appointed volunteer pitch inspectors can be expected at all matches
- the referee may carry out the inspection electronically if he has the possibility, but he must also keep a physical record
- the option "status OK" entered on the data uploaded on the official website does not in itself give the right to play,
- the player must also provide the referee with appropriate identification (DE student card, UniPass card, ID card, driving licence) for the match in question, without which he will not be allowed on the pitch
- the use of shoes appropriate to the type of pitch is permitted: indoor shoes for indoor pitches, indoor shoes for open pitches and shoes with artificial turf and small cleats
- **all teams are required to complete the registrations requested by the organisers by the closing date: online registration (<http://www.buzanszkykupa.hu>), paper registration (to be submitted at a predetermined location), bid or sponsor registration (based on the decision of the committee)**
- **after the first warning for any deficiencies after the deadline, a point deduction and then disqualification may be applied to any team**
- We ask all teams entering the league to refrain from using obscene names, the use of such team names is strictly prohibited!

7. Safety of the field of play and its immediate surroundings:

- the participating teams are responsible for the safety, cleanliness and behaviour of their supporters on the field of play and its immediate surroundings, if this is not satisfactory, the referee may stop the match, discriminate against the team at fault
- the consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited on the indoor playing field and in the stands (DESOK Sports Hall, Agricultural Sports Hall)

8. Final provisions:

If 2 or more teams are tied on points, the following criteria will be used to rank the teams:

- **the result of the match against each other**
- **aggregate goal difference**
- **more goals scored**
- **all-out match for 2 teams, draw for more teams**

Starting from the current semester, the following ranking classes are available.

Superliga

- DIV I pre-qualified teams, in addition to teams that have qualified in DIV II and who have agreed to compete in the higher division
- participation in the President's Cup for teams that do not finish in the top 4

DIV II Division

- in addition to teams that have pre-qualified for DIV II, proposed for teams that finished in the top 4 in DIV III in the last semester

DIV III Division

- in addition to teams that have not qualified for DIV II, proposed for newly entered teams without legal successor
- an unlimited number of participating teams is possible

For the teams that qualify from both lower divisions, participation in the higher division will be strictly compulsory from the autumn semester 2022/23, and optional for the other teams that reach the quarter-finals.
